## Getting your Spotify Client ID

Guess Hit Right's browser version lets you play quizzes from your own Spotify playlists. To connect Spotify, you need a free "Client ID" from your own Spotify Developer app — this takes about two minutes and this guide walks through every screen.

This is a one-time setup per device — once saved, Guess Hit Right remembers it for next time.

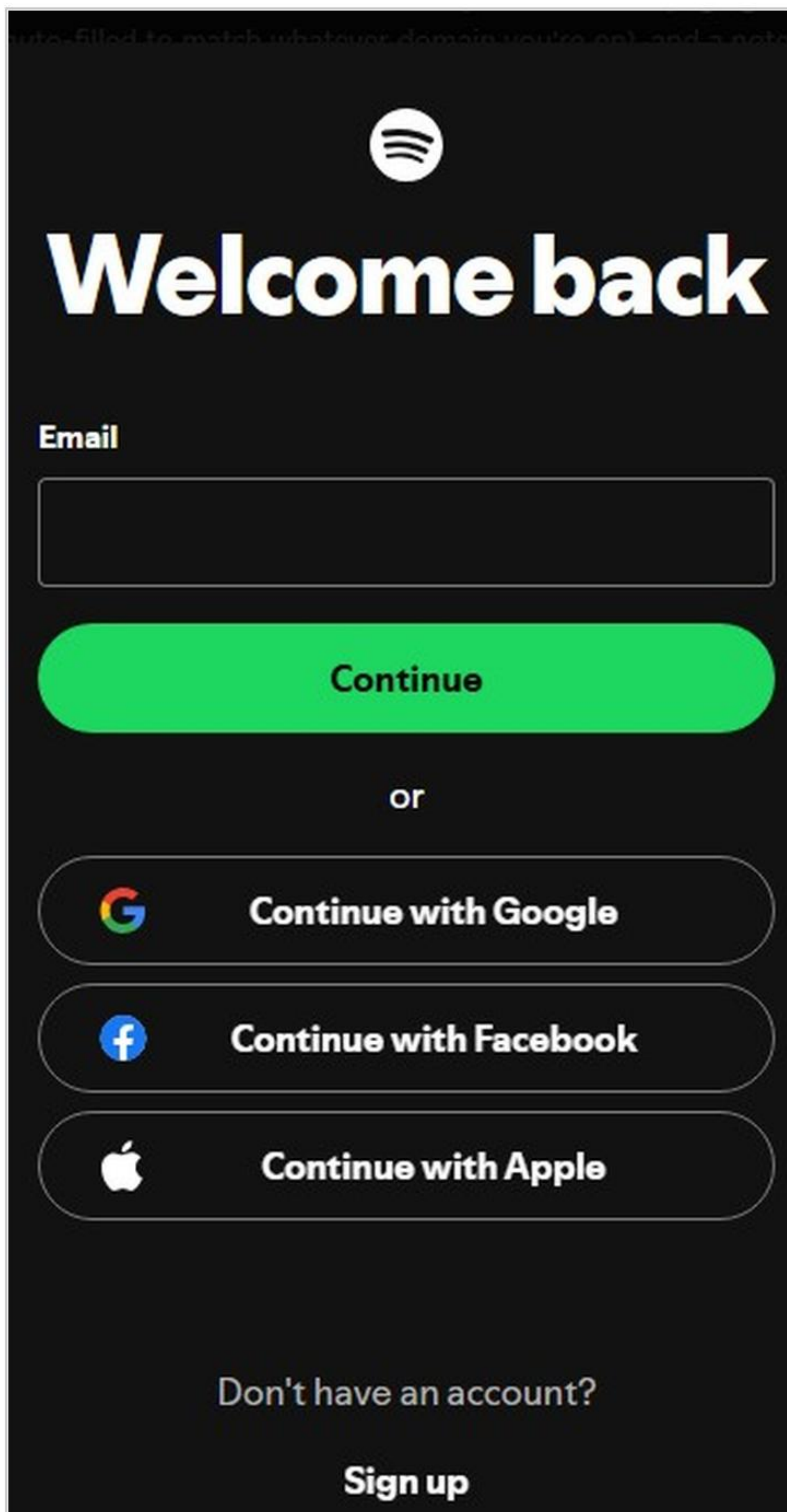

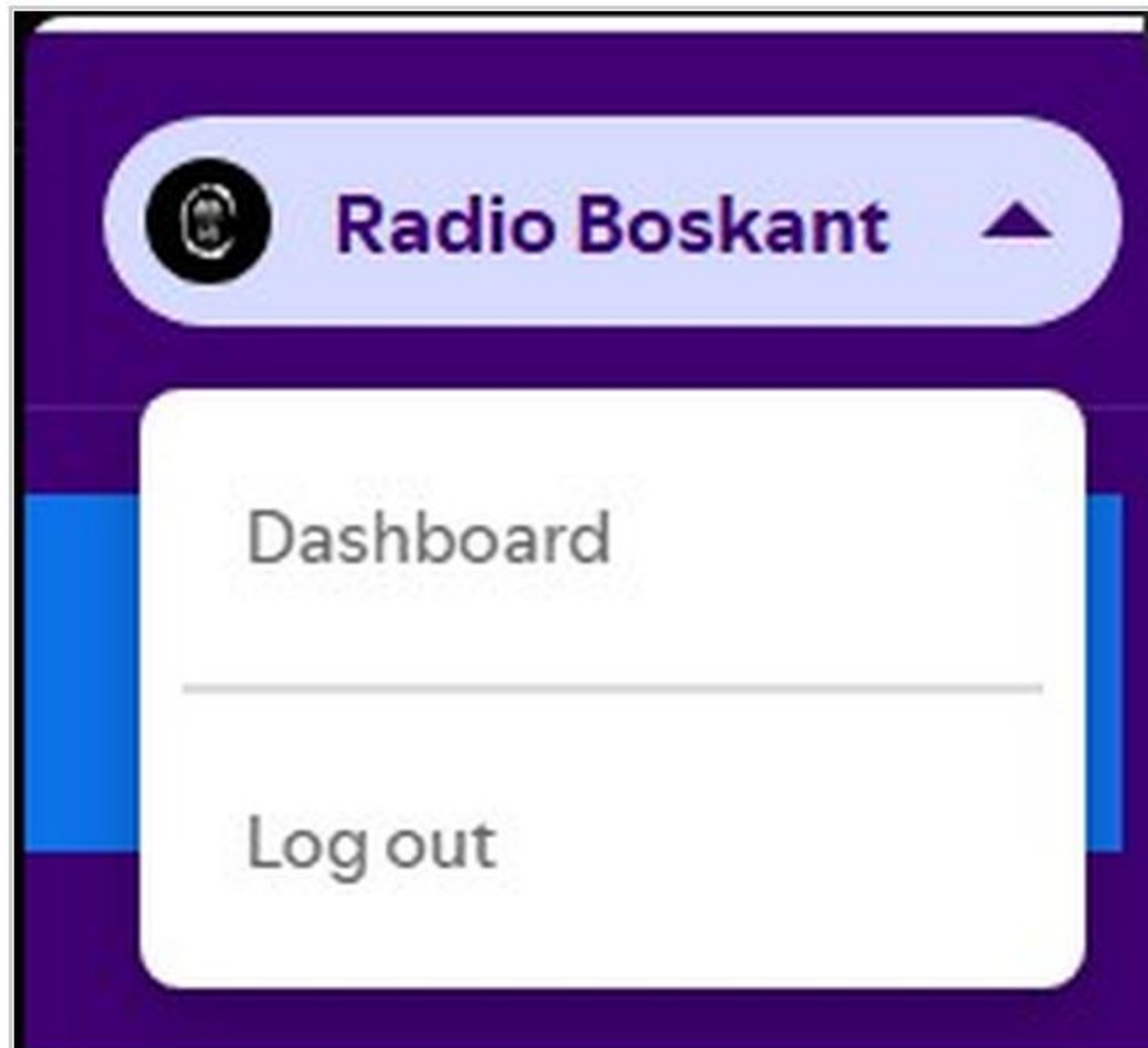

Good to know

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## Development Mode

New Spotify apps start in "Development Mode" — only Spotify accounts you add under Settings → User Management in your app can log in (up to 25). That's plenty for personal or small-group use.

## Your Client ID isn't secret

It's fine to have it visible on screen or shared — it never leaves your browser except to talk to Spotify directly, and no password or payment info is ever involved.

## One-time setup

Once you save the Client ID and log in once, Guess Hit Right remembers it on this device — you won't need to repeat these steps next time you play.
